



# IN-HOME COVID-19 VACCINATIONS & BOOSTERS

Do you care for someone who has difficulty leaving home? You can help them to schedule a free in-home COVID-19 vaccination or booster regardless of insurance, citizenship, or immigration status!

## Who is Eligible:

### Everyone age 5 and older who:

- Is eligible for a primary or booster dose **AND**
- Has an injury, developmental disability, medical or mental health condition that makes it difficult to leave the home **AND**
- Would require a considerable and taxing effort to get vaccinated outside the home

**Note:** *Ages 5 -17 only get Pfizer.*

## Available Vaccine Doses:

- **1st and 2nd Primary** doses for everyone age 5 and older.
- **3rd Shot** for eligible immune-compromised people, age 5 and older, to complete their primary series.
- **1st Booster** for everyone age 12 and older.
- **2nd Booster** for everyone age 50 and older and eligible immune-compromised people age 12 and older.

- During the homebound person's appointment, the vaccination team can also vaccinate other people in the home who need primary or booster doses. If there will others, please mention this when you call for the appointment.
